This gives them the opportunity to avoid the stigma (and possible effects) of a juvenile record.
- ☐ The **Cecil County Mediation Center** provides conflict resolution services through mediation, education and training. They promote respectful resolution of conflicts and disputes.
- ☐ **Fair Hill Nature Center** connects children and adults to the environment by educating, engaging and exploring our local natural resources.
- ☐ **Generation Station** provides a safe, supervised and structured environment for youth, including after-school help with homework, summer day camps, community service opportunities, volunteerism, study groups, computer classes, organized recreation and field trips.
- ☐ **Open Door** offers a safe haven for families to have supervised visitation and monitored exchanges when involved with separation, divorce or court mandated protection orders.
- ☐ **Youth Empowerment Source** provides critical supports to children, youth and families in Cecil County - with a strong focus on prevention and education.
